

Trio of webinars Exploring the Arts in Therapeutic Settings.

First one of these webinars will be presented on 6 June by **Michelle Booth** entitled The Power of Art and Dance from 18h00 - 19h30.

Michelle Booth is a registered Art Therapist, facilitator and coach. She graduated with a Bachelor of Business Science from UCT in 1992. She then worked in the NGO field and as a management consultant in Cape Town. In 2002, she graduated with a post graduate diploma in Fine Art and in 2006 she completed her Masters in Art Therapy in Edinburgh, Scotland and returned to South Africa in December 2006.

From 2007 -2016 she lived in Johannesburg where she worked as an art therapist in private practice and for the Sophiatown Community Psychological Services, where she worked with refugees, home based care workers, care workers in homes and shelters and directors of NGO's. She has a particular interest in the intersection of the personal, organisational and social/political aspects of her work with both individuals and groups.

She also was involved in various projects over the years at Lefika la Phodisa, including training community art counsellors. She was instrumental in reviving SANATO and was on the national committee of SANATO from 2009. She led the transition to its formal establishment as a professional association SANATA in May 2019 and has been the Chairperson since then.

She moved to Knysna in 2016, where she works in private practice and with an NGO called KILT (Knysna Initiative for Learning and Teaching) where she runs teachers wellness groups and leadership development programmes.

Michelle is also trained as a facilitator of Biodanza, an international method of dance and movement and has been leading classes and workshops since 2009.

In this webinar, participants will be introduced to the field of Art Therapy: a creative and expressive approach to psychotherapy for adults and children. The Arts Therapies are not well known or understood although most educators and those working with children understand the inherent value of creativity as a part of self expression and communication.

Visual creative art making in the context of Art Therapy is largely process driven rather than didactic in nature an allows unconscious material to surface into the particular therapeutic container provided by the therapist.

The purpose of this webinar is for participants to understand this therapy approach in a general introductory sense; understand how to work alongside Arts Therapists and what referrals are appropriate; and for participants to understand how this approach to therapy can support the people they are working with in their own professions.
