Established in 2003, her reading centre provides reading assessments, remedial intervention, and workshops to children of all ages who struggle with reading. In addition, she is the Master Licensee for the Cellfield reading intervention which she brought to South Africa from Australia in 2004. She has developed and presented reading-related workshops and talks for parents, teachers, specialists and scholars both locally and internationally, including "Experiencing Child with Learning Difficulties", "The Multifaceted Nature of Reading" and "Developing Inferential Skills". Angela is dedicated to assisting children with reading difficulties so that they can experience academic success with confidence and a positive self-esteem.
